Medical Data Recovery Source, Inc. (MDRS) understands the importance of maintaining the security and confidentiality of your personal information.

MDRS provides secure management of your personal medical information via the internet with a goal of improving your health and reducing costs for medical services through accurate record management.

Technologies: MDRS has designed and developed the *mdrscard* system to ensure the protection and privacy of your information using state-of-the-art internet technologies. The MDRS system is housed in a state-of-the-art data center located in Central NY using the secure (Secure Socket Layer – SSL) certificates and 128-bit encryption to ensure the protection of your personal medical information.



Information Availability: The MDRS system has been designed for access to your information 24x7, 365 days a year. Your information is backed up on a daily basis and our data center has protection against power failure through backup power and generation systems.

HIPAA Compliance: The Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act, also known as HIPAA, is designed to protect the handling and distribution of personal health information by health care providers. Although MDRS is not a health care provider, our system is designed to comply with the HIPAA standards for handling of your electronic medical information.

Protecting Your Privacy: MDRS will not sell or distribute any of your personal information and will only use member information internally for the purpose of generating statistics about how the site is used by members.

Requesting CD Copies of Your Medical Information: The MDRS system is designed to maintain and access your personal medical information in electronic form via the internet. Users with a Premier membership will receive a copy of their records in a Portable Document Format (PDF) format on CD once per year as part of their normal membership fee. Should you desire to receive a copy of your medical information in either printed or in a Portable Document Format (PDF) and you are not a premier member, MDRS will provide this service to members via a personal information release request for a small processing fee.
